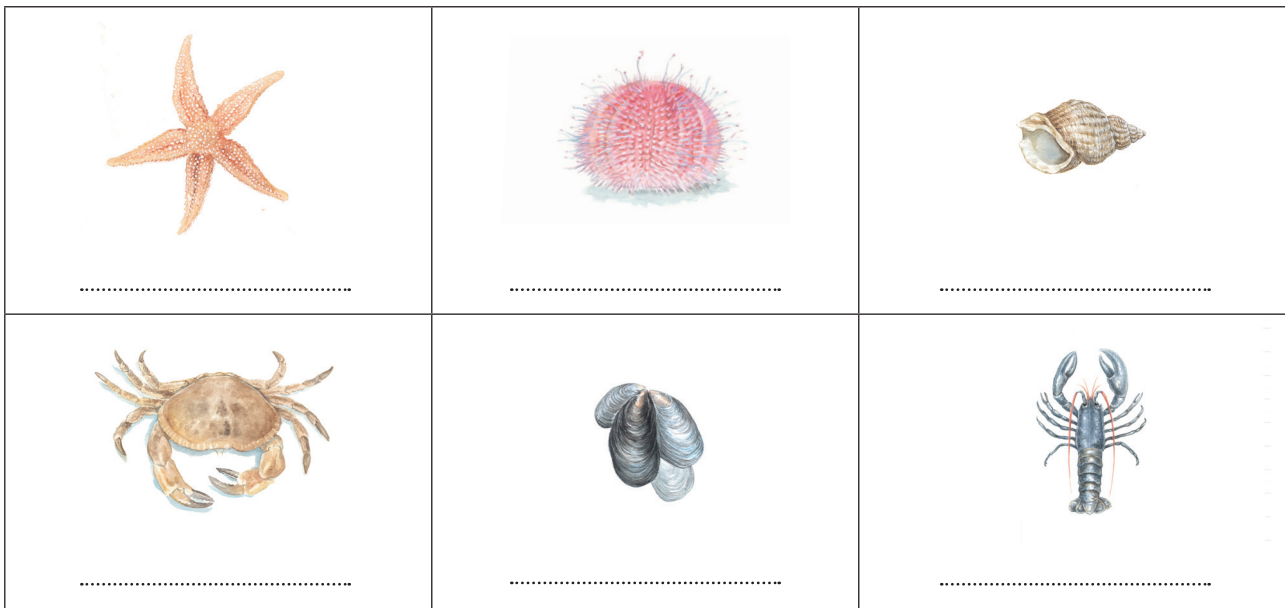


Invertebrates

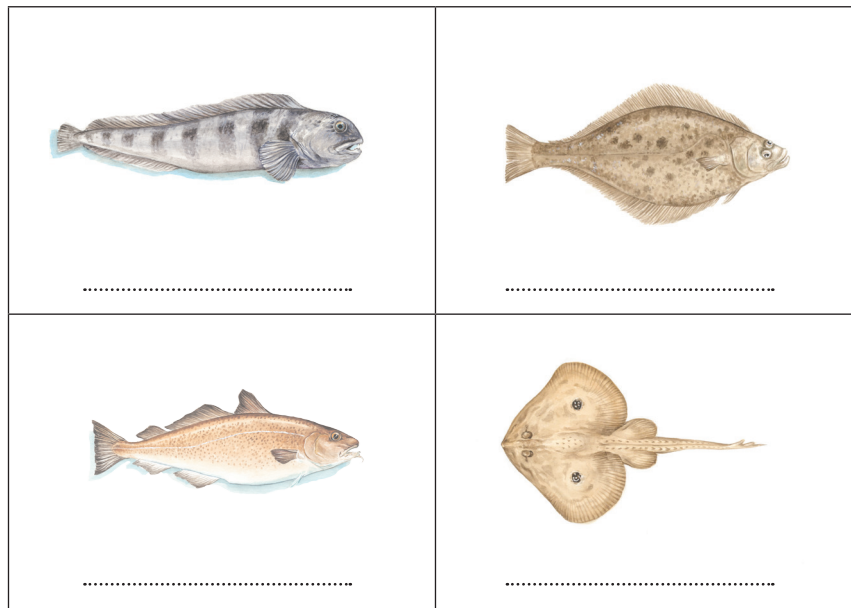
Look closely at the pictures of these Moray Firth sea creatures and answer the questions to help you identify each one with its correct name.



- Does the animal have a hard outer shell?
 - Yes: go to 2
 - No: go to 7
- Does it have 10 legs, including two front pincers?
 - Yes: go to 3
 - No: go to 5
- Does the outer shell cover both the head and the body?
 - Yes: Crab
 - No: go to 4
- Does the shell have a separate body and head sections?
 - Yes: Lobster
- Is the shell in two parts?
 - Yes: Mussel
 - No: go to 6
- Is the shell in one part with spirals around it?
 - Yes: Whelk
 - No: go to 7
- Is the animal round and covered in spines?
 - Yes: Urchin
 - No: go to 8
- Is the animal flat and symmetrical in shape with five or more limbs?
 - Yes: Starfish

Fish

Look closely at the pictures of these Moray Firth sea creatures and answer the questions to help you identify each one with its correct name.



1. Is the fish flat in shape?

Yes: go to 4

No: go to 2.

2. Does the animal have a long body with a large head?

Yes: Wolf fish

No: go to 3

3. Does the animal have a 'barbel' on its chin?

Yes: Cod

4. Is the animal's eyes on one side of its body and its mouth on the other side?

Yes: Halibut

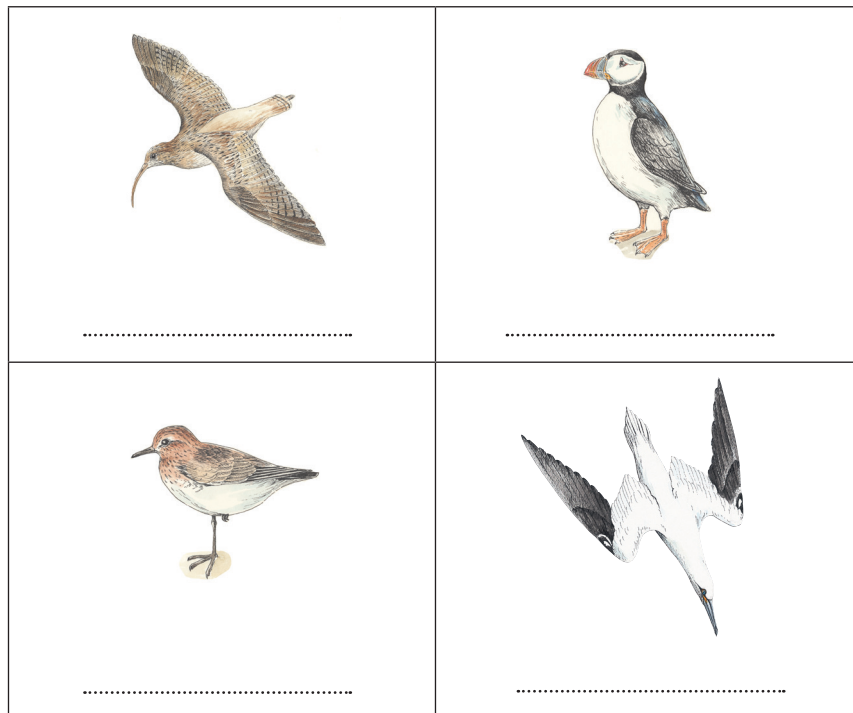
No: go to 5

5. Fish has eyes on top of its head and a long tail?

Yes: Cuckoo Ray

Birds

Look closely at the pictures of these Moray Firth sea creatures and answer the questions to help you identify each one with its correct name.



1. Does the animal have webbed feet?

Yes: go to 2

No: go to 4

2. Does the animal have a short colourful beak?

Yes: Puffin

No: go to 3

3. Does the animal have long streamlined wings?

Yes: gannet

4. Does the animal have a long curved beak?

Yes: Curlew

No: go to 5

5. Does the animal have a short beak and red feathers?

Yes: Sanderling
