














**Predators and Prey in the Moray Firth

<p><b>Starfish</b></p> 	<p>I use my tube feet to open the hard shells of this animal.</p>	<p><b>Sand Eel</b></p> 
<p><b>Wolf Fish</b></p> 	<p>My powerful jaws can crunch through the shell of my prey, even though it is covered in spines.</p>	<p><b>Worms &amp; Shrimps</b></p> 
<p><b>Sand Eel</b></p> 	<p>I hide in the sand and when my food floats past I swim up and grab these tiny animals.</p>	<p><b>Shore Crab</b></p> 
<p><b>Octopus</b></p> 	<p>I am an expert at avoiding the sharp pincers of my food.</p>	<p><b>Urchin</b></p> 
<p><b>Flounder</b></p> 	<p>I move slowly across the seabed looking for small animals hiding under the sand and mud.</p>	<p><b>Mussel</b></p> 
<p><b>Human</b></p> 	<p>I like to catch big fish and make them into fish fingers.</p>	<p><b>Animal Plankton</b></p> 
<p><b>Puffin</b></p> 	<p>I dive into the water to catch my favourite meal; I can carry 10 of these small thin fish in my beak at one time.</p>	<p><b>Cod</b></p>
