A starfish's tummy is underneath its body.

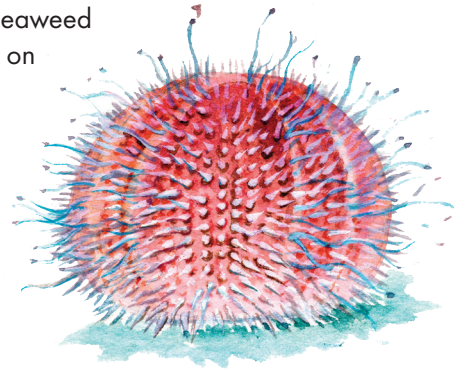

The hermit crab lives inside an old snail's shell.

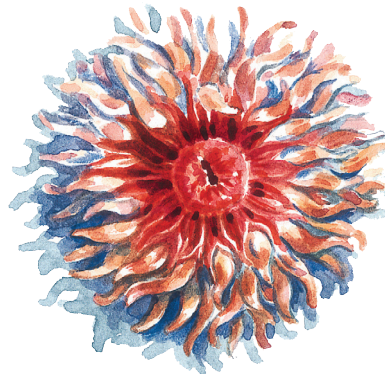
