| 3. Does the outer shell cover both the head and the body? | Yes: Crab No: go to 4 |
| 4. Does the shell have a separate body and head sections? | Yes: Lobster |
| 5. Is the shell in two parts? | Yes: Mussel No: go to 6 |
| 6. Is the shell in one part with spirals around it? | Yes: Whelk No: go to 7 |
| 7. Is the animal round and covered in spines? | Yes: Urchin No: go to 8 |
| 8. Is the animal flat and symmetrical in shape with five or more limbs? | Yes: Starfish |








Fish

Yes: Cuckoo Ray






