



AN OCEAN OF CHANGE

Learning Level Third, S1-3 **Time** 2 hours

Plastics are part of our everyday lives, but when they get into the ocean they become a persistent problem with far reaching impacts. This workshop focusses on plastic problems that we can't even see and explores the types and sources of microplastic waste typically found at the beach, the impacts that this waste has on ocean life and what we can do to help.

Activities

A guided tour of the aquarium Handling live marine animals Interactive plastics workshop including extraction of microplastics from sand.

Key Concepts

Plastics (derived from petroleum) are persistent in the environment and negatively impact sea life.
