Learning Level Early
Time 1.5 hours

Plastic is everywhere and plays an integral part in our daily lives. While exploring the exciting underwater world of the Moray Firth discover some of the impacts that plastic waste has on the marine environment. Children will encounter hundreds of different animals in a variety of habitat themes and get the opportunity to handle hardy rock pool critters. Through storytelling this programme explores the impact of lost balloons on the marine environment and the importance of reducing, reusing, recycling and caring for our environment.
