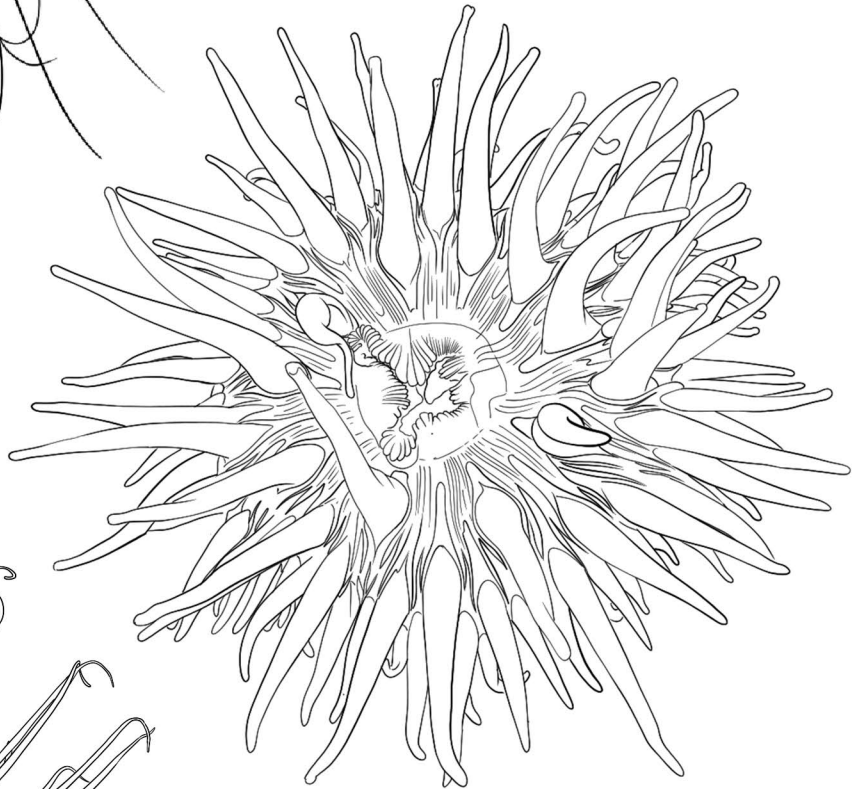
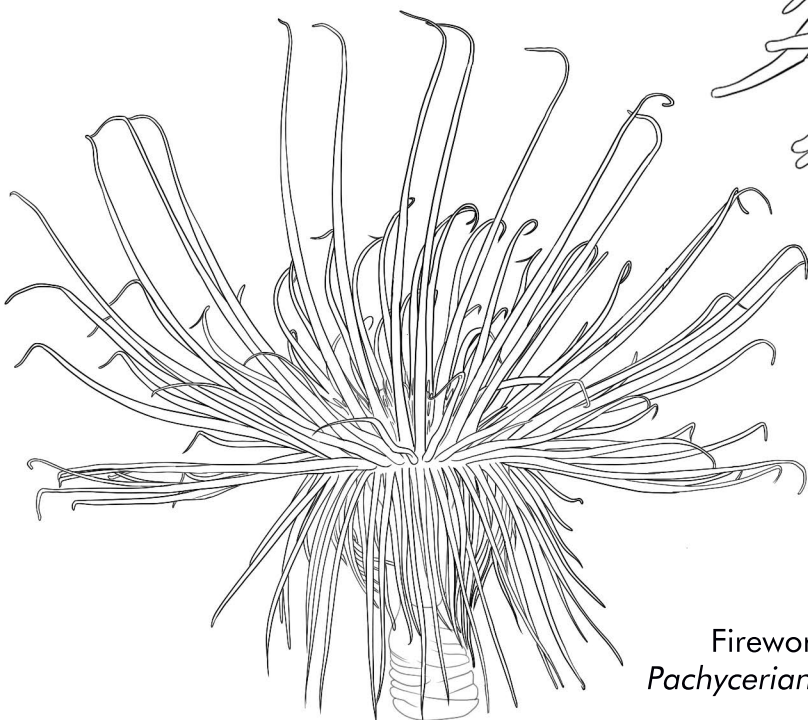


Mauve Stinger
